

Land & Sea in Lamu



What awaits you in Lamu

Lamu hosts remarkable mangrove forest channels, extensively rich seagrass beds, unexpected sandbars, resilient and unusual coral reefs and untouched beaches. The Lamu Archipelago is a critical nesting ground for a variety of turtles—the green, hawksbill, and occasionally, the olive ridley. There are plenty of opportunities to get out there by swimming in the mangrove channels, snorkelling on the reefs (Kinyika island, Pezali island), swimming the creeks, waterskiing, kayaking, stand up paddleboarding or just jumping in for a dip with the dolphins along the shore line.

Your Private Dhow

This gorgeous traditional Dhow screams elegance, luxury and adventure at sea.

You have plenty of room for lounging, sunbathing, looking out for marine life, taking in the 360 degree views of your blue environment. You get to sleep under the stars every night, with a warm sea breeze and the gentle sounds of water while you anchor in a shielded bay.

The crew led by a wonderful captain will guide you around Lamu island. The boat will be your 'mother ship' so to speak and from here, you will venture out to Kinyika island, the mangrove channels, the sand bar. You can swim, snorkel and fish and if lucky, you might find yourselves alongside turtles and dolphins.

The dhow comes with a chef and crew who will ensure you are very well looked after.

Your Coastal Hideaway

For the second half of your safari 'a deux', you'll spend 2 wonderful nights enjoying an island escape in a beach side Cabana.

The cabana offers cool, comfortable, and romantic accommodation - with its own large netted double bed, bathroom, private terrace, made entirely of palm thatch. You have use of a shared pool with amazing panoramic views, wifi, and lovely food.

If you fancy a little pampering after a day of activities you can always arrange a soothing/relaxing massage with the accommodations in house Masseuse.

You are literally on the beach, so it is easy to step out for a walk, kayak or swim. From here you can have an evening sundown waterski in the creek too.

Your Itinerary

Day 1 - Team will meet you at the Manda airstrip (around 3.45 pm) and transfer you to the luxury dhow, swim, explore mangrove creeks and beaches, sundowners on the rooftop, supper under the stars. Anchor off Ras Kitau - The perfect start to your romantic getaway and celebration of your time together.



Day 2 - Morning chill and swim, excursion to Kinyika island which has wonderful snorkelling, possible viewing of dolphins and home to many seabirds. Drinks/bittings on board. Stop off at the Kizingoni sand bar for picnic lunch – walk the largest sand dune ever, find loads of wonderful sand dollars. Back to the luxury dhow, relax and enjoy chilling, stand up paddle board or kayak in the afternoon. Sundowners and Supper.



Day 3 - Early morning watersports up the creek followed by breakfast - either on the boat or somewhere in the channels. Back to the Luxury dhow for your last few hours on board - you have the choice to kayak, swim, stand up paddle board, or head back out to Kinyika looking for dolphins. Light lunch and then onto your next destination - Island Escape at the Cabanas. Arrive from 15:00 hours...once settled in relax and enjoy sundowners on your own verandah.

Day 4 - Full day to do lots of walking, kayaking, swimming or just nothing. I would recommend walking around the point and finding a secluded spot around the point along the Lamu island beach... you can get away from everyone and everything. Back for a light lunch up near the pool. Enjoy a sundowner sail.



Day 5 - Morning walk and swim, breakfast and then consider taking the boat back to the sand bar, or up the channels for some water sports. Lunch at 1 pm and departure around 2 pm to catch the afternoon flight to Nairobi from the Manda Airstrip.
